



May Day is celebrated on May 1. This secular holiday goes back to ancient times and is a yearly ritual to celebrate the bounty of spring. Typical festivities include flowers, dancing, and maypoles, which are tall poles decorated with ribbons and flowers erected for revelers to dance around. Traditionally, wreaths of posies adorn heads and bouquets are quietly left on the doorsteps of neighbors and friends as gestures of friendship.

Mother's Day was proposed by Anna Jarvis of Philadelphia in 1907. West Virginia was the first state to recognize the holiday in 1910, and President Woodrow Wilson officially proclaimed Mother's Day a national holiday in 1914.
