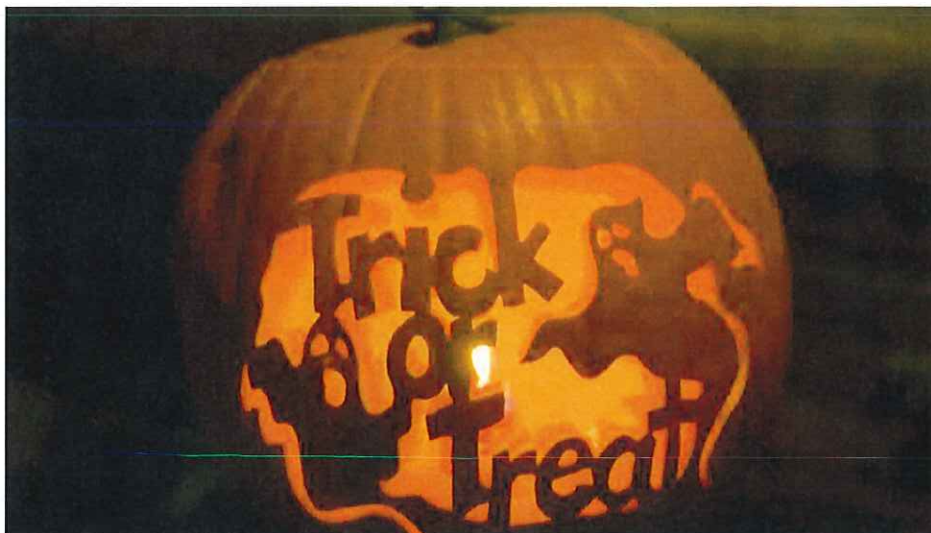
Happy Halloween!

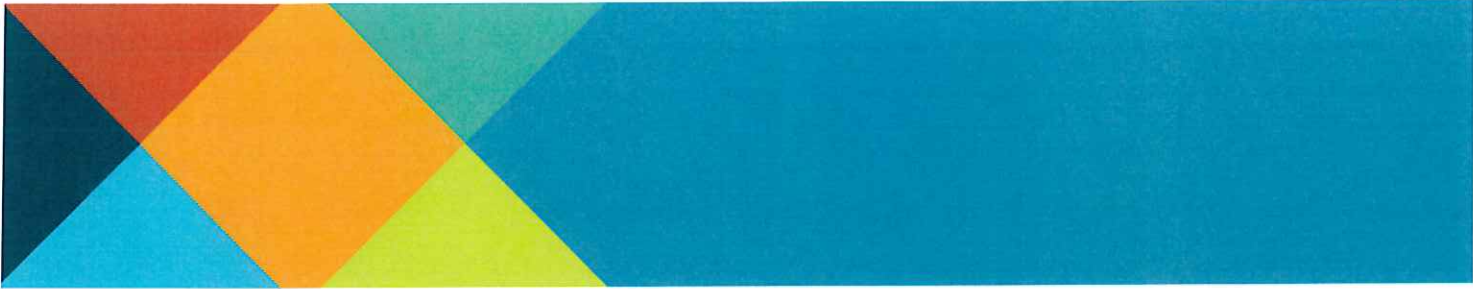
