

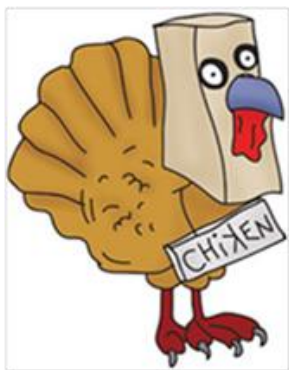

- Wild turkeys can run up to 20 miles per hour when they are scared

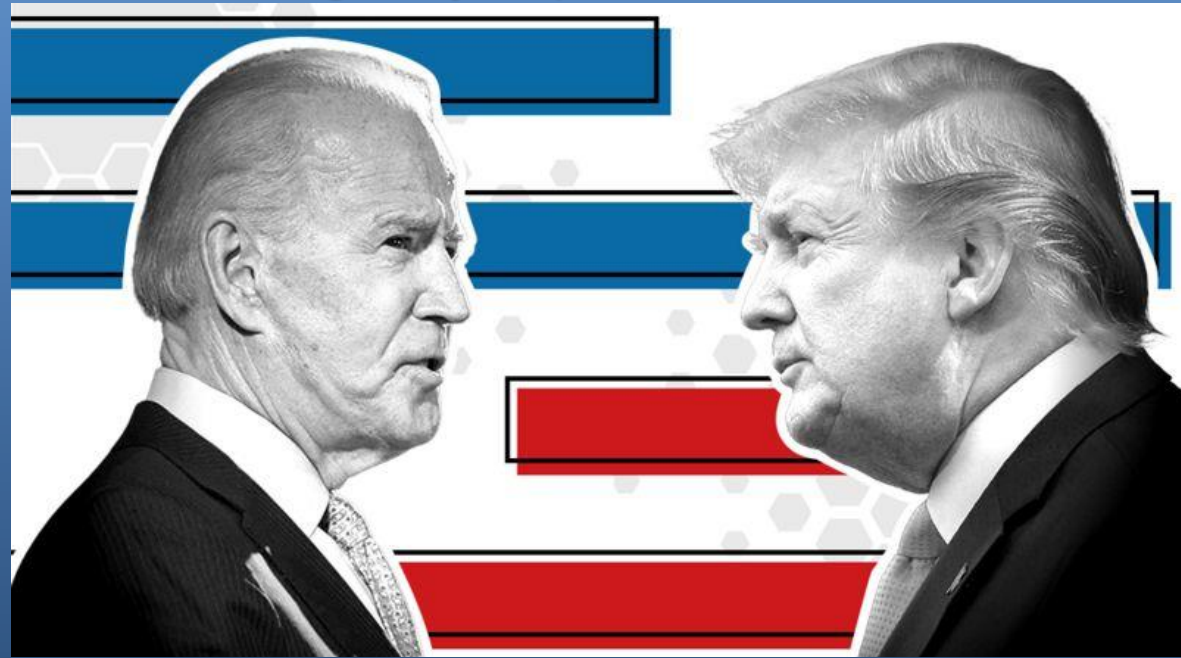

Veterans Day November 11, 2020

Veterans Day honors all of those who have served the country in war or peace — dead or alive — although it's largely intended to thank living veterans for their sacrifices. It was originally called Armistice Day, commemorating the end of World War I.

On Memorial Day and Veterans Day, millions of red crepe paper poppies—all handmade by veterans as part of their therapeutic rehabilitation—are distributed across the country in exchange for donations that go directly to assist disabled and hospitalized veterans in our communities.

Its estimated that 300,000 US WWII veterans are still alive in 2020. Veterans only make up 10% of the US population.
